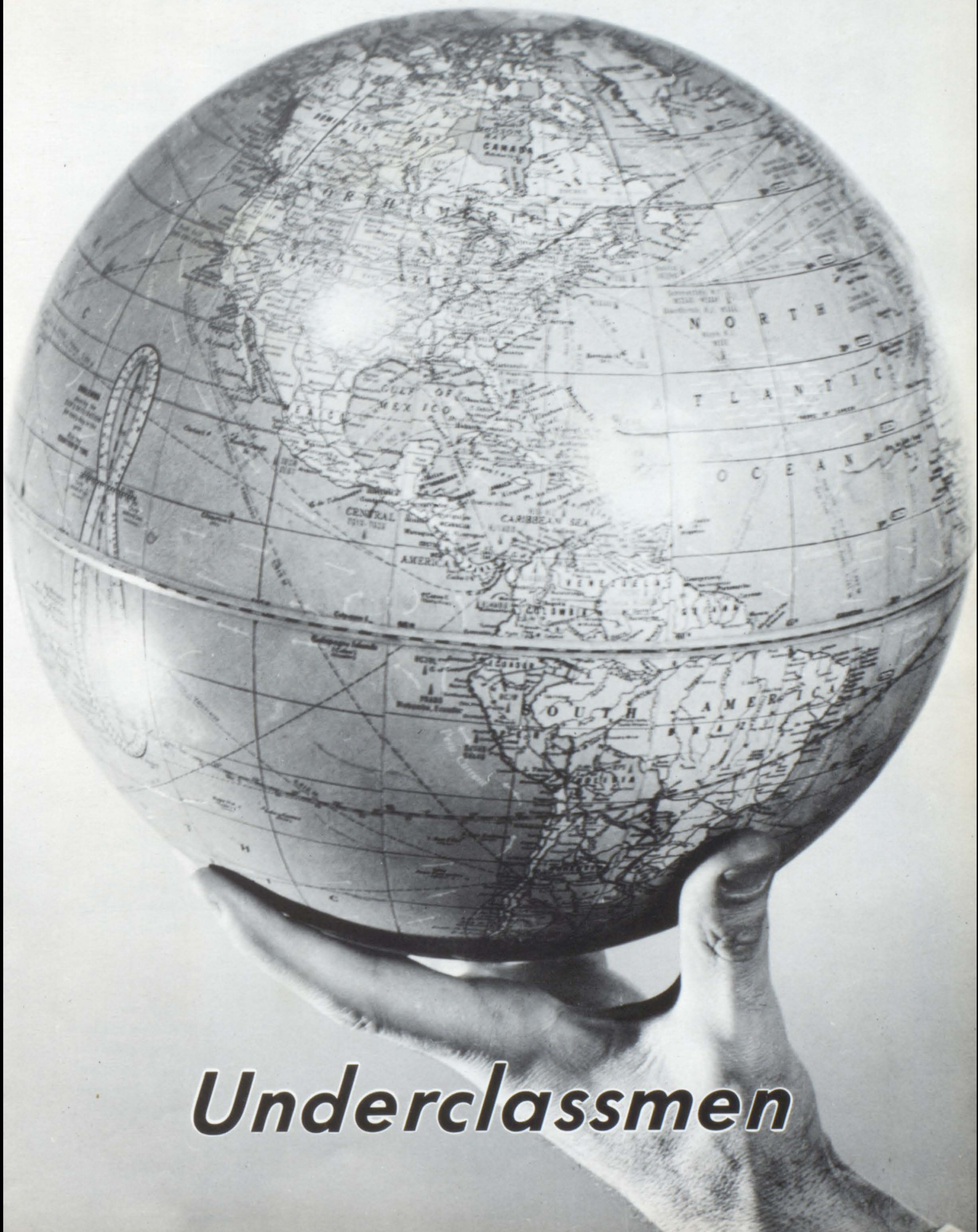
### SENIOR MAGAZINE SALES

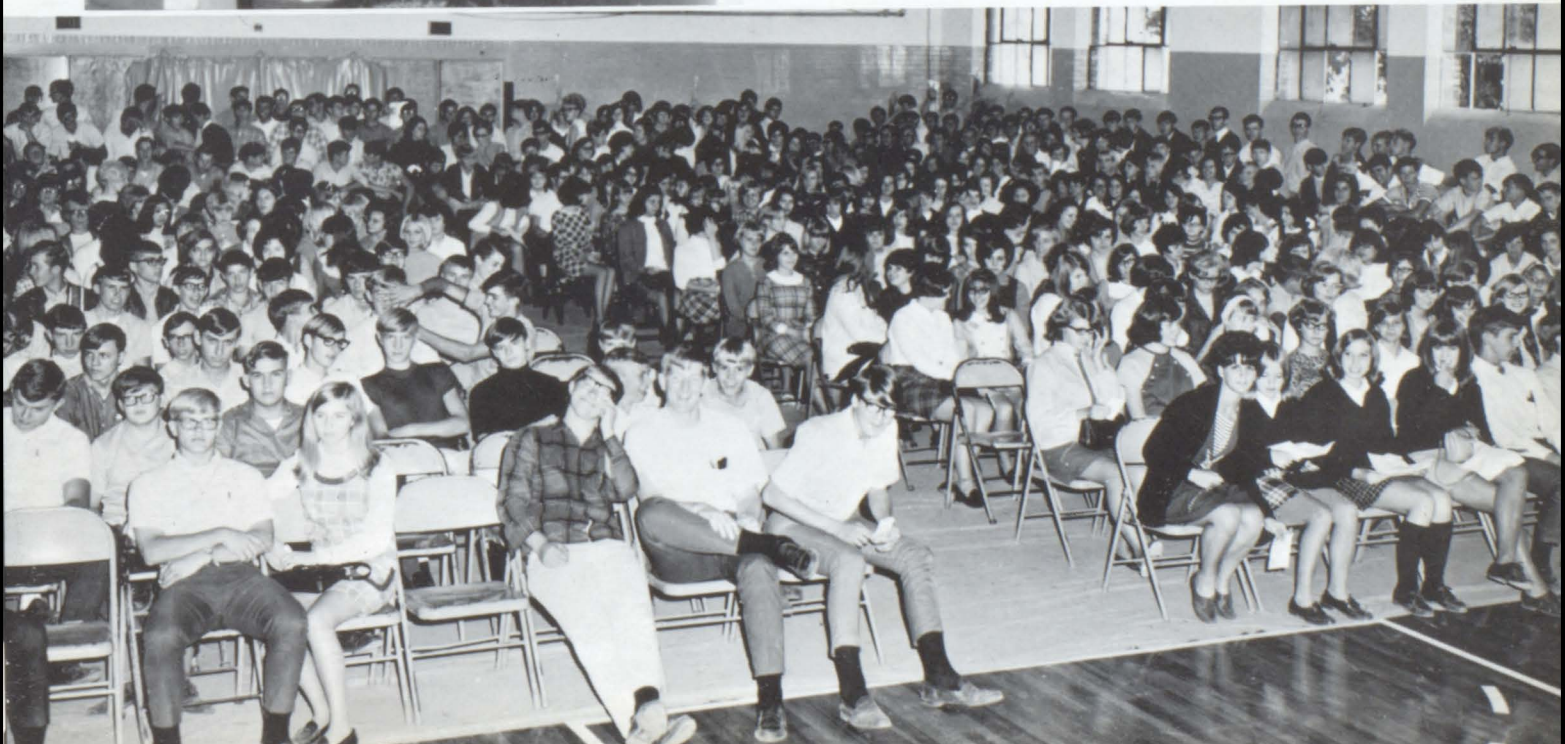
