DEDICATION

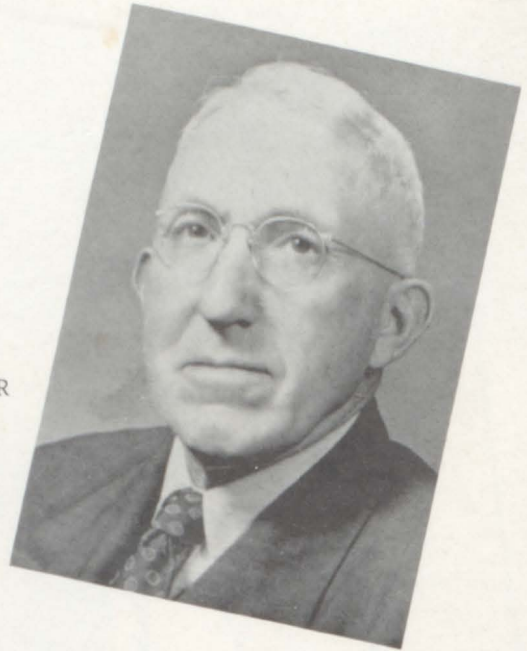
