

# RAINBOWS




The rainbow holds a promise for us. Its hues of red, orange, yellow, green, blue, and violet are the colors of our emotions.

Yellow gives the feeling of uncertainty or anxiety. Because there is uncertainty in life, people have hope for the future and hope causes people to make their lives better.







Green, the color of jealousy, which is better known as envy, pushes people to strive to improve themselves. School rivalries, academics, and contests are examples.
