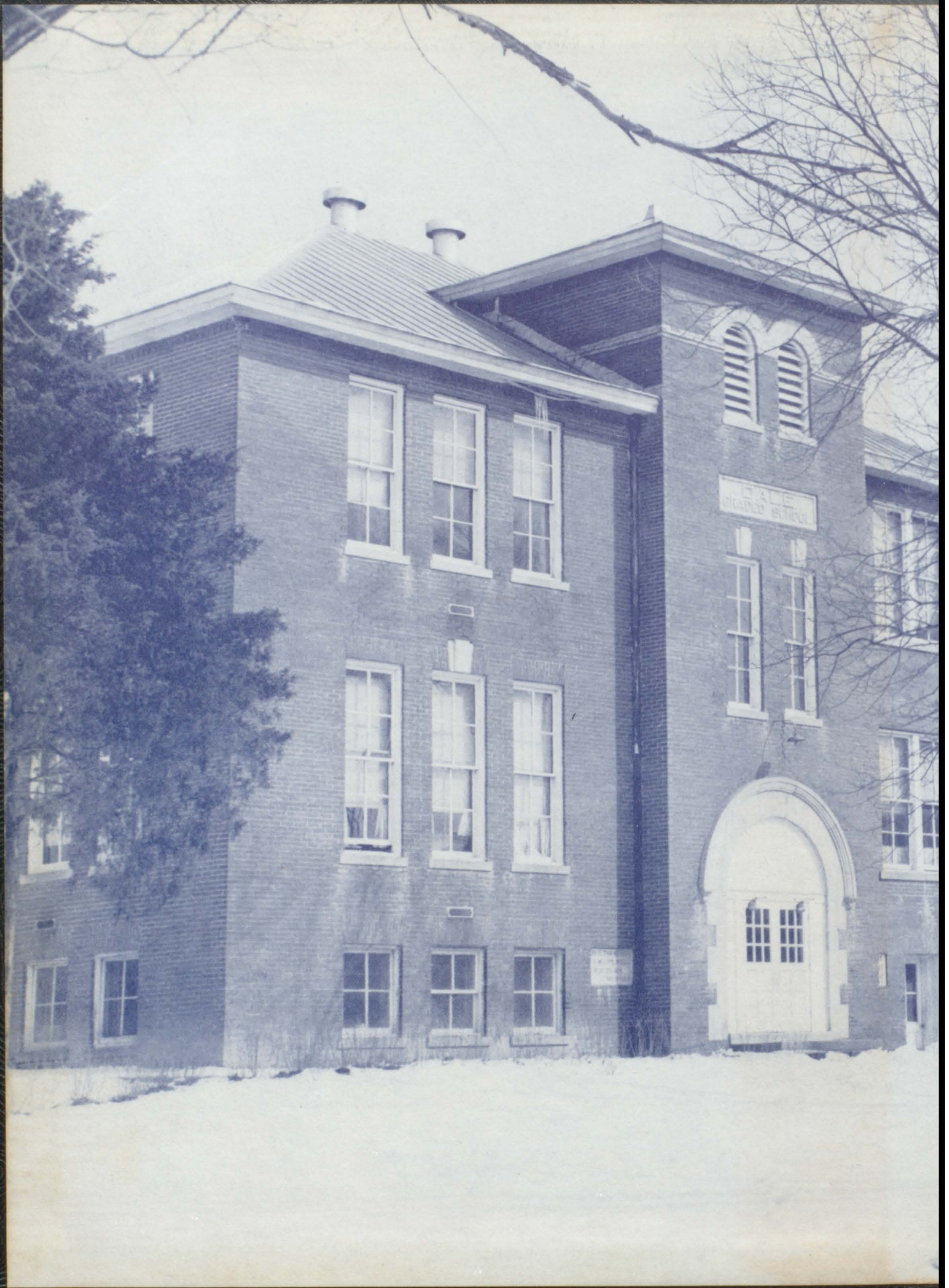


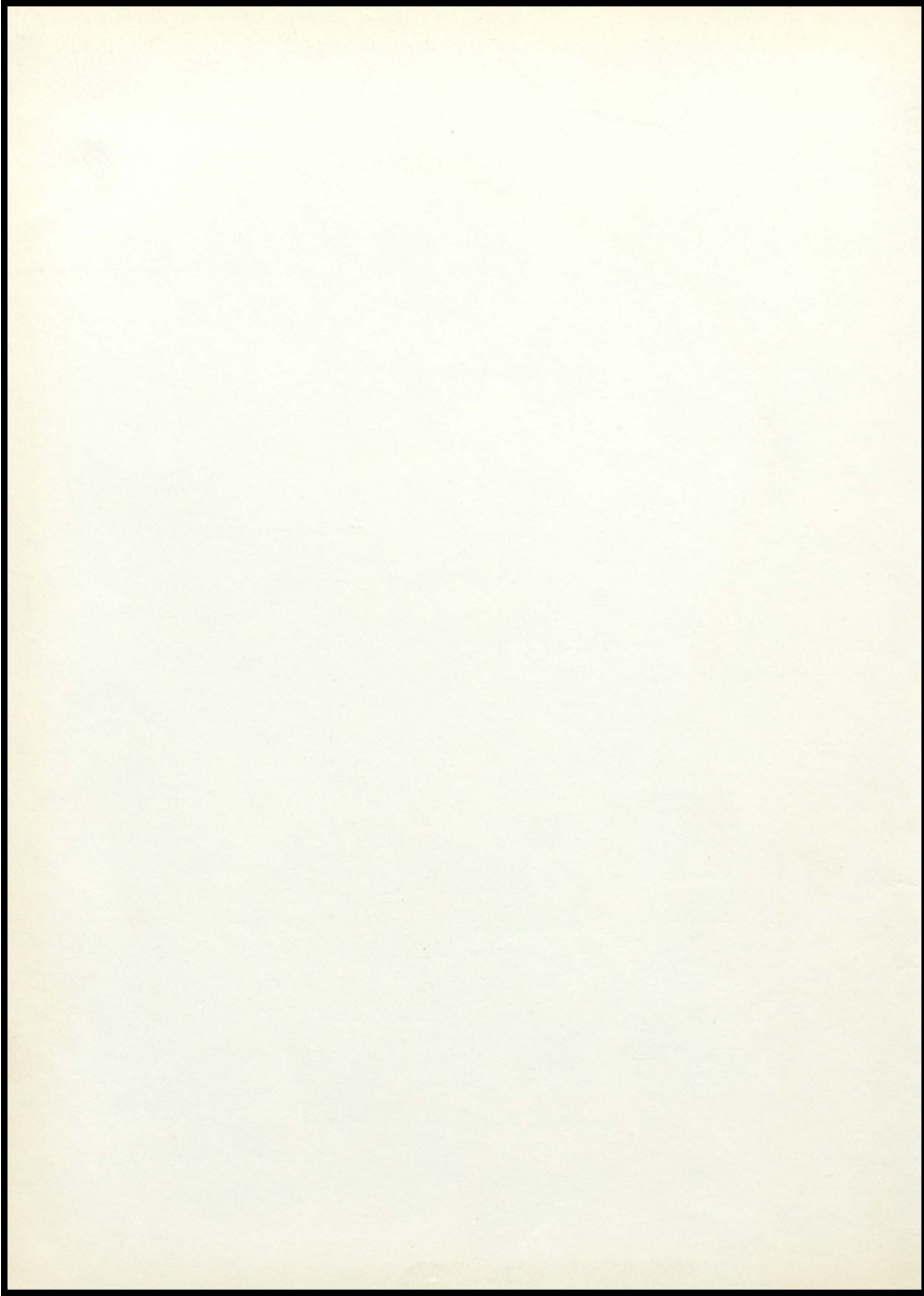

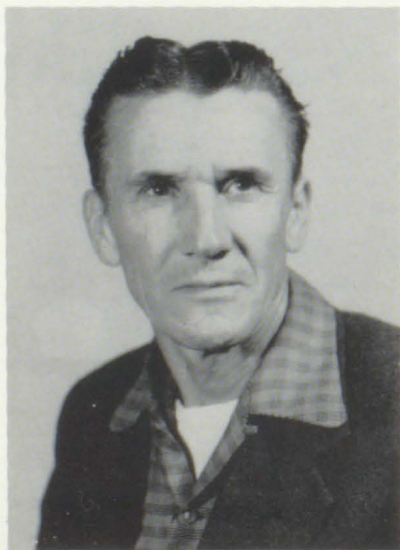
Principal's Message

Their sponsor, Mrs. Moseley, deserves a special hand for helping to make our cheerleaders a source of pride.

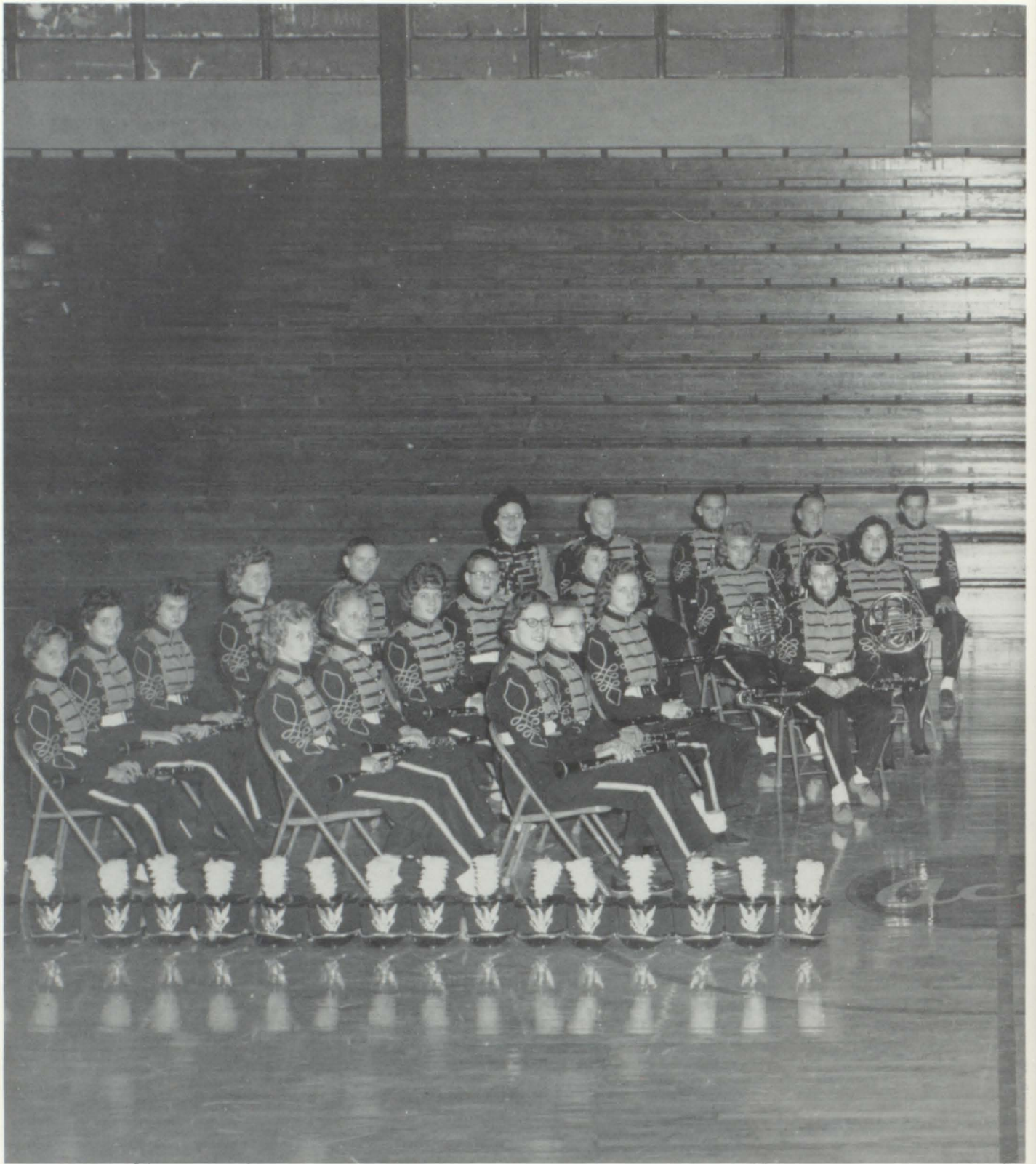

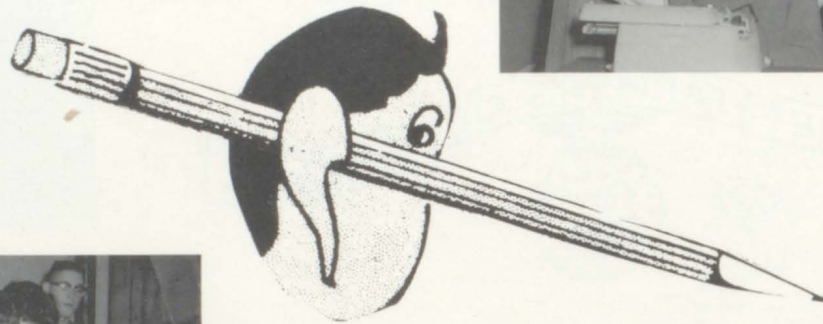

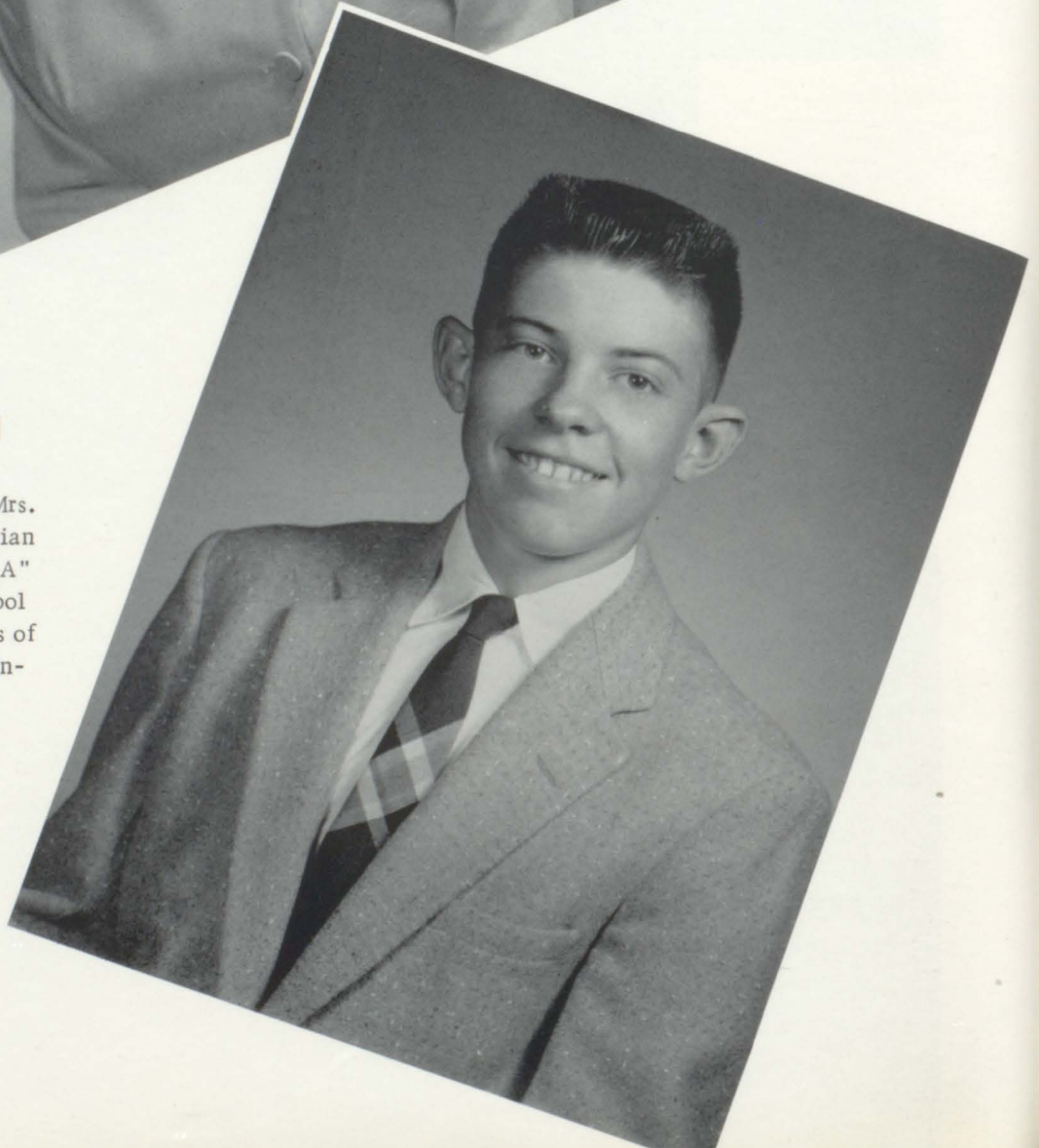
Valedictorian

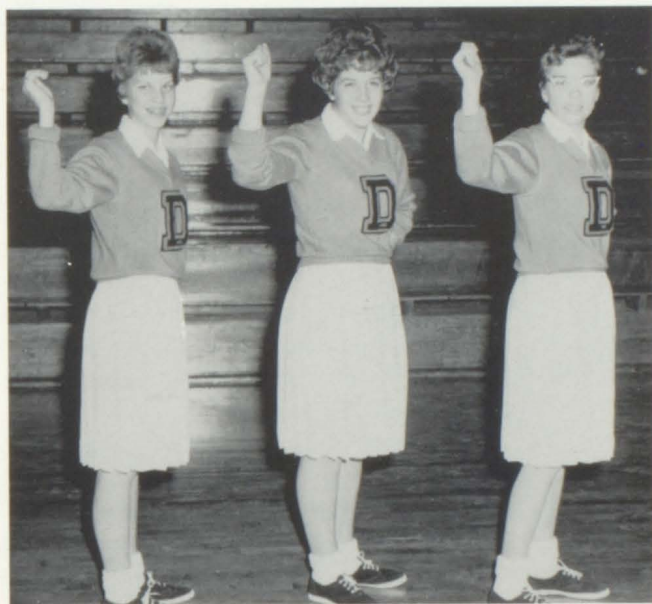


Reserves
