


PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Each year Spier Spencer Chapter of American Revolution sponsors a contest known as "Indiana's Good Citizen Contest."


A student is chosen from each school in the county to represent her school as a good citizen. Carolyn Henry was chosen to represent our school in the county contest.
