

This Reflector of 1958 is dedicated in the memory of Gurley A. Hopper who died May 25, 1957. Mr. Hopper, starting his career at Judd School at Lynnville, had been a teacher for twenty-five years. He received his B.S. degree from Oakland City College in 1932 and obtained a high school license in Social Studies and Science. In 1949 he received his Master of Science degree in Education from Indiana University and his elementary and high school principal's license in 1950.

Mr. Hopper had been a high school principal for four years. After he served as principal for two years at Lynnville High School, he was principal for two years from 1955-1957 at Chrisney.

In April 1957 he received license for Superintendent, and shortly before his death he had been elected Superintendent of Spencer County Schools.

We at Chrisney High School have been privileged to have had Mr. Hopper as our principal for two years. He was not only a principal but also an advisor and friend as well. We are sure that all former students of his are deeply appreciative of his influence and steadfast guidance which has helped them become a better person.
