SENIOR PLAY



Charles Winkler, called Bill by his friends, is valedictorian of the class of 1962. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Winkler of Dale.


Bill, who maintained an "A" average, was editor of the annual and president of the Student Council.

Other activities were the Senior-FacultyTea, and two class parties. Class rings and jackets were ordered.

Football queen attendants were Janet Johnson and Susanna Shelton. Activities included giving the junior play, GRANDMA'S BEST YEARS, selling concessions, and giving the junior-senior banquet and prom.
